SECTION I — Your Freedoms, Protected in Law

- ✓ The right to use cash — no one can be forced into a digital-only economy
- ✓ No mandatory digital ID — identification stays voluntary, never a condition of daily life
- ✓ No debanking — no one loses access to banking over lawful political views
- ✓ Free speech — protected expression, not permission-based speech
- ✓ Judged by people, not algorithms — no automated scoring of citizens
- ✓ Freedom of conscience — the right to dissent without penalty

SECTION II — Warning Signs Are Already Here

- ✓ Censorship pressure on lawful speech, online and off
- ✓ Expanding surveillance sold as safety and convenience
- ✓ Creeping ID checks for everyday, ordinary activities

SECTION III — Technology Must Serve The People

- ✓ No social scoring of any kind
- ✓ Privacy by default in every public system
- ✓ Canadian data stays accountable to Canadian law
- ✓ Real recourse — a human to appeal to, and a way to be heard

SECTION IV — Renewing Democracy

- ✓ Direct democratic tools — more say, more often
- ✓ Open, fair broadcast of public debate
- ✓ Diversity of voice — no monopoly on the conversation
